NOTICE INVITING BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Barstow, 220 East Mountain View, Barstow, Calif. 92311, until 2:00 P.M. on August 12, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers at City Hall for the new fire suppression system for the kitchen hood at Desert Manna in accordance with contract documents and specification therefore, as follows:

Barstow: Fire Suppression System for Kitchen Desert Manna

This CDBG construction project is relating to the removal of the old fire suppression system and installing a new wet chemical fire suppression system per UL300 at Desert Manna located at 209 N. First Ave. The project includes the submittal of the new fire suppression system to the Barstow Fire District for their approval and permit. The new system shall meet the 2008 California Mechanical Code requirements.

Contract Documents and Specifications may be obtained from the Office of the City Building Official, 220 East Mountain View, Barstow, California 92311 upon payment of \$25.00, un-refundable for each set.

The City of Barstow, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252) and the regulations of the Department of Commerce (15 C.F. R., Part 8) issued pursuant to such act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that the contract entered into pursuant to the advertisement will be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, or national origin.

The requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this project and those requirements will be enforced. The prime contractor and all subcontractors are required to pay their laborers and mechanics employed under this Contract, a wage not less than minimum wage classification as specified in both the Federal and State Wage Decision when the Contract amount for the Prime Contract exceeds \$2,000. The higher of the two applicable wage classifications, either State Prevailing Wage or Davis-Bacon Federal Prevailing Wage, will be enforced for all work under this Contract. The prime contractor is responsible for ensuring subcontractor compliance with Davis-Bacon and related Act Requirements. The Federal Labor Standards Provisions (HUD 4010) apply to this project.

PAYMENTS - A weekly certified payroll is required during the term of construction. Payment of invoice may be delayed when certified payrolls are not submitted weekly. The City shall make progress payments on any properly completed payment request submitted by the Contractor.

The payment request shall not be deemed properly completed unless certified payroll form WH 347 has been properly completed and submitted on a weekly basis for each week worked during the time period covered by said payment request.”

The successful bidder must possess a valid "C-16" license from the State of California.

The City of Barstow reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in a bid, or to make awards in the best interest of the City.
