**NOTICE INVITING BIDS**

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Barstow, 220 East Mountain View, Barstow, Calif. 92311, until 2:00 P.M. on September 9, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers at City Hall for the installation of new kitchen improvements for the Barstow Senior Center at 555 Melissa Ave in accordance with contract documents and specification therefore, as follows:

**BARSTOW: KITCHEN IMPROVEMENTS FOR SENIOR NUTRITION PROGRAM - BARSTOW SENIOR CENTER**

This construction project is relating to the installation of new kitchen equipment for the stem table at the Barstow Senior Center located at 555 Melissa Ave. in Barstow, CA. The project includes removing the existing gas warming trays and system and the refrigerated tray and compressor and installing new electrical heating system for the steam trays and new tray and compressor for the refrigerated area. This will require a new electrical circuit for the electrical heating units. The door to the walk in cooler is being replaced.

Contract Documents and Specifications may be obtained from the Office of the City Building Official, 220 East Mountain View, Barstow, California 92311 upon payment of \$25.00, un-refundable for each set.

The bid must be accompanied by a bid guarantee in the amount of 10% of the total bid. More specifically, pursuant to Public Contract Code §§ 20170 and 20171, all bids for the project shall be presented, under sealed cover and shall be accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid: (a) cash; (b) a cashier's check made payable to the City of Barstow; (c) a certified check made payable to the City of Barstow; or (d) a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer made payable to the City of Barstow. Such security shall be forfeited should the successful bidder to whom the contract is awarded fails to timely execute the contract and to deliver the necessary bonds and insurance certificates as specified in the contract documents.

Pursuant to California Civil Code § 3247, a payment bond is required to be submitted for all projects estimated in excess of \$25,000.00.

[Optional language to require bond when the project value is less than \$25,000.00: “This is a statutory minimum requirement. While this project is not in excess of \$25,000.00, the City nevertheless requires a payment bond to accompany this bid.”]

To the extent applicable, at any time during the term of the Agreement for the proposed project, the successful bidder may, at its own expense, substitute securities equivalent to the amount withheld as retention (or the retained percentage) in accordance with Public Contract Code § 22300.

The City of Barstow, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252) and the regulations of the Department of Commerce (15 C.F. R., Part 8) issued pursuant to such act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that the contract entered into pursuant to the advertisement will be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, or national origin.

The City has determined that the proposed project is a public works subject to the provisions of Labor Code § 1720 thereby requiring the Contractor to pay the prevailing wage rates for all work performed under the Contract.

**LANGUAGE FOR PROJECT FUNDED BY FEDERAL GRANT:** “For project funded by a federal grant: The requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this project and those requirements will be enforced. The prime contractor and all subcontractors are required to pay their laborers and mechanics employed under this Contract, a wage not less than minimum wage classification as specified in both the Federal and State Wage Decision when the Contract amount for the Prime Contract exceeds \$2,000. The higher of the two applicable wage classifications, either State Prevailing Wage or Davis-Bacon Federal Prevailing Wage, will be enforced for all work under this Contract. The prime contractor is responsible for ensuring subcontractor compliance with Davis-Bacon and related Act Requirements. The Federal Labor Standards Provisions (HUD 4010) apply to this project.”]

**PAYMENTS -** A weekly certified payroll is required during the term of construction. Payment of invoice may be delayed when certified payrolls are not submitted weekly. The City shall make progress payments on any properly completed payment request submitted by the Contractor.

The payment request shall not be deemed properly completed unless certified payroll form WH 347 has been properly completed and submitted on a weekly basis for each week worked during the time period covered by said payment request.”

**The successful bidder must possess a valid "C-38" license from the State of California.**

The City of Barstow reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in a bid, or to make awards in the best interest of the City.
