NOTICE INVITING BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Barstow, 220 E. Mountain View St., Barstow, California 92311, before 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 31, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read for Project #'s: 2010-12, 2010-13. Main Street: Avenue A to Avenue H and Main Street: Avenue A to Second St. – Streets Reconstruction which consists of asphalt pavement, curb, gutter, driveway, markings, and striping replacement.

Base bid \$ 3,154,594.00**

To guard against premature opening of the bid, formal bid documents shall be submitted by bidder in a sealed envelope clearly labeled with the project title, name of bidder and date and time of the bid opening.

A mandatory bid walk will occur at the City of Barstow at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 11, 2010.

Said work shall be performed in strict conformity with the plans and specifications, therefore being Project #'s: 2010-12 & 2010-13, now on file in the Office of the City Engineer. Electronic copies on CD-ROM of said plans and specifications may be obtained by prospective bidders from Merrell-Johnson Engineering for a non-refundable fee of \$15.00 if physically picked up at 12138 Industrial Blvd., Ste. 240, Victorville, CA 92395 or \$45.00 if mailing is required. The City of Barstow, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252) and the regulations of the Department of Commerce (15 C.F.R., Part 8) issued pursuant to the advertisement will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, or national origin.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check payable to the order of the City, or by a bid bond executed by a corporate surety authorized to do business in the State of California in the sum of not less than 10% of the total amount of the bid, as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the proposed contract if it be awarded him.

The bidder to whom the contract is awarded by the City shall execute the contract and furnish a surety bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price guaranteeing the faithful performance of the contract and it shall remain in force for a period of one year after final acceptance. An additional bond for 100% of the contract price shall be furnished to secure the payment of claims for labor and materials furnished for the work.

Bidders are advised that this project is funded with Community Development Block Grant Funds. The requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this project and those requirements will be enforced. The prime contractor and all subcontractors are required to pay their laborers and mechanics employed under this Contract, a wage not less than minimum wage classification, as specified in both the Federal and State Wage Decision

when the Contract amount for the Prime Contract exceeds \$2,000. **The higher of the two applicable wage classifications, either State Prevailing Wage or Davis-Bacon Federal Prevailing Wage, will be enforced for all work under this Contract.** The prime contractor is responsible for ensuring subcontractor compliance with Davis-Bacon and related Act Requirements. The Federal Labor Standards Provisions (HUD 4010) apply to this project.

A copy of the Davis-Bacon Federal Prevailing Wage, the date of which reflects the latest applicable modification at the time of this advertisement, is included in the Contract Documents & Specifications. Bidders shall be notified, via Addendum, of modifications, if any, which supersede that included herein, up until a minimum of ten (10) days prior to the actual Bid Opening.

All bids are to be compared on the basis of the Engineer's estimate of the quantities of the work to be done.

No Bid will be accepted from a contractor not having the required license issued at the time of bids in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9, Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. Contractors' license classification required for this project is Class **A**. The City reserves the right to retain all bids for a period of 45 days for examination and comparison, and to delete any portion of the work from the contract. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in such bids, or to make awards in the best interest of the City.

Ten percent (10%) will be deducted from each progress payment and retained by the City and the remainder less the amount of all previous payments will be paid to the Contractor.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code ("PCC") §22300, the Contractor may substitute securities for the retention monies held by the City or request that the City place such monies into an escrow account. The Contractor is notified, pursuant to PCC §22300, any such election will be at the Contractor's own expense and will include costs incurred by the City to accommodate the Contractor's request.
