

The City of Barstow is proud to present a new skateboard park at Dana Park. Our goal is to ensure your safe enjoyment of this facility. The City has adopted rules for use of the City's skateboard park. We kindly ask that you read these rules, and that you be courteous to others. Have a fun and safe skating experience!

The Barstow Skateboard Park is open Monday through Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to Dusk*

GENERAL SKATEBOARD PARK RULES

1. Skateboarding is a Hazardous Activity – All users of the skateboard park skateboard at their own risk. The City of Barstow does not supervise the skateboard park and is not liable for injuries pursuant to California Health and Safety Code sections 115800, *et seq.*

2. No person shall use the skating surface of a skateboard park for any use other than proper use of a skateboard.

3. No motorized vehicles allowed.

4. No person shall use the skating surface of a skateboard park unless that person is wearing proper safety equipment, including at least a helmet, elbow pads and knee pads, which is in good condition and designed and approved for such activity. All helmets and pads must be fastened while skateboarding.

5. No person shall introduce, employ or use any unauthorized equipment, obstacles or apparatus within a skateboard park.

6. Skateboarding is prohibited on curbs, planters, benches, stairs/steps, railing, parking lots, walls, and driveways within the city limits.

7. No person shall use alcohol or non-prescribed drugs or medication for which a prescription is required within 300 feet of a skateboard park, where such prescribed drugs or medication may affect one's ability to safely operate a skateboard.

* The hours of operation are subject to change without notice. The park will be closed periodically for maintenance and repair. The skate park is also subject to closure due to weather conditions.

8. No person shall use prescribed drugs or medication in or within 300 feet of a skateboard park, or under the influence of the same while at a skateboard park, where such prescribed drugs or medication may affect one's ability to safely operate a skateboard.

9. No person shall apply graffiti or otherwise deface a skateboard park.

10. No person shall play amplified music within a skateboard park or use audio headsets while in a skateboard park.

11. No person shall permit spectators to enter into the skating area of a skateboard park.

12. No person shall enter or remain in a skateboard park with any food, beverages or glass containers. All trash must be placed within the trash receptacles provided for such purpose.

13. No skateboarding on wet surfaces.

14. The skateboard park will be closed during inclement weather.
15. No person shall, other than during posted hours of operation, use a skateboard park, unless first expressly authorized by a city representative in writing. The City's curfew ordinance shall be strictly enforced.
16. No special events or contests are allowed in the skateboard park, unless authorized by the City of Barstow.
17. The City of Barstow is not responsible for loss or damage to skateboards or other personal property.
18. No person shall use profane or abusive language or act in any discourteous manner while at a skateboard park.
19. No person shall throw a skateboard or launch a skateboard toward spectators or other skaters.
20. All users of the skateboard park shall be courteous to others and welcome new skaters.
21. All users of the skateboard park shall share the skating area with other users.
22. Barstow Municipal Code Chapter 9.28 shall be enforced at the skateboard park. Violations of Chapter 9.28 shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 9.28.080 of the Barstow Municipal Code.
23. No person shall skateboard in a skateboard park owned and operated by the City, unless the individual using a skateboard in a skateboard park is age 12 years or older. Individuals under the age of 12 years old shall be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
