Construction Waste Management Plan

- City Protocol
 - ▣ Construction Waste Management Plan Application
 - Determine if the project will meet the criteria
 - 1,000 Square feet or more of new construction
 - Have the applicant fill out the application
 - Provide the brochure to them

Construction Waste Management Plan

- Burrtec Waste Industries Exclusive Franchise
 - ▣ Options for hauling and managing construction material:
 - Self-haul to recycling facilities
 - Primary contractor has license/permits for hauling
 - Use of Burrtec Waste as the Exclusive hauler for the City
 - Provides complete container management and tracking/recording of the materials diverted.
 - Provides report to user and to the City

Construction Waste Management Plan

- County of San Bernardino Recycling Program
 - ▣ Program which takes place at the face of the landfill
 - ▣ Developed in 2005 to target C&D
 - ▣ Program arrived in Barstow Fall of 2006
 - Driven by Barstow as we are considered “isolated” from markets
 - Only one market for C&D/Inerts in town; Concrete Recycling
 - Enables City to realize diversion from the landfill

Construction Waste Management Plan

- Burrtec Landfill Diversion Program
 - Activity/sorting will take place at the face of the landfill
 - C&D Items removed/pulled from the box will be:
- **Wood**
- **Mixed C&D**
- **Inerts**
- **Asphalt Based - Composite Roofing**
- **Metal**
- **Cardboard**

Construction Waste Management Plan

- No additional cost to Contractor for Compliance
 - Cost of containers is the same
 - Contractor can use one bin and segregate waste
 - Implement Best Management Practices on job-site
 - Keep lunch trash out of rolloff boxes
 - Compliance is “invisible” and “painless”
 - City of Barstow is very “Building/Growth Friendly”
